• The Supporting company may not, under any circumstances, advertise or promote their association by Unrestricted Educational Grant. Any concessions to this rule must be requested to and approved by the EUROPACE 2007 Committee.

Learning Village Overview

What are the components of the Learning Village:

• A Room, or rooms, separate from the Exhibition Area but to be considered as complimentary to and part of the Exhibition as far as Industry showcasing their products and applications is concerned.

• The Learning Village will be open during Exhibition Hours only.

• All training and workshops will not be part of the scientific programme and will be considered as an extension of Industry Exhibition Activity but in a designated area for ease of access and quietude to visiting delegates.

• The company or companies involved in the Learning Village would be responsible, on their booth, to enlist delegates to sign up for attending the workshops according to a regulated schedule.

• The Learning Village will contain such device/equipment as virtual cath labs, implant simulator equipment, other simulators, several pacing pieces, lead placement equipment and so forth.

• Hands-on sessions only, no lecture, presentation or film allowed.

• The duration of the sessions should not be limited but the number of attendees shouldn't exceed 10 per session.
