Welcome Letter

Dear Industry Partners,

Welcome to an exciting new initiative that builds on the European Society of Cardiology's (ESC) commitment to fighting heart disease around the world: *ESC Asia with APSC & AFC*.

At the invitation of - and with the enthusiastic support from - the Asian Pacific Society of Cardiology (APSC) and the Asean Federation of Cardiology (AFC), the ESC will hold this pioneering, three-day event in Singapore, from 8 - 10 November 2019. It builds on ESC's reputation in the region as a renowned and trusted learned society. Tens of thousands of healthcare professionals in Asia already turn to the ESC to stay up to date on the latest cardiovascular science. They register in our database and subscribe to our journals. There will be a special emphasis on helping junior cardiologists or cardiologists in training by providing a clinical case competition, hands-on sessions for computed tomography and echocardiography, and a session on how to write a good scientific paper or abstract.

The exhibition area will allow delegates to exchange with key industry experts on critical areas of development and research in cardiovascular products and therapies. There will also be opportunities for delegates to get hands-on and/or one-on-one learning from clinical and technical experts.

The fight against cardiovascular disease is a shared mission in which you are our valued partners. 
