
- 4,664 registered delegates from 107 countries/territories


Live programme

• 1,422 delegates attended the live programme over the 2 days of the event (attendees) (Digital Health Week: 1,033)



Unique viewers - Live programme






- 33.4% of attendees both days of the event

Session attendees



Event attendees

- 1,422 delegates (30.4% of total registered delegates) from 75 countries logged on to the congress platform to watch sessions live as they were broadcast. (Digital Health Week: 1,033 from 97 countries. 25.7% of total registered delegates.)
- A further 65 delegates logged on to the congress platform during congress dates and <u>only</u> viewed ondemand content.
- In total, 1,487 delegates (31.8% of total registered delegates) logged on to the congress platform during the congress dates and watched live and/or on-demand sessions. (Digital Health Week: 29.3% of total delegates; ESC Congress: 62%)


Attendee profiles

- 1,487 delegates (31.8% of total registered delegates) from 82 countries/territories logged on to the congress platform during the congress dates and watched live and/or on-demand sessions.
- 76% of delegates came from Affiliated Cardiac Society countries (Digital Health Week: 18%)
- 8% from National Cardiac Society countries (Digital Health Week: 76%)
- **16%** from rest of world (Digital Health Week: 6%)
