



Conditions of sales

Order Forms need to be signed by an authorised company representative, only signed order forms will be taken into consideration.

Transfer - even in part - of the rights and obligations arising from the order to third parties is not permitted.

An invoice will be sent to the company by email.

It is the ESC's policy that all invoices must be paid by the date indicated on the invoice (30 days from date of invoice) or before the opening of the event, should this date fall first. Any late payment shall result in the application of an interest for late payment no lower than 3 times the legal interest rate, in addition to a fixed compensation for recovery costs of forty (40) euros.

This Order subjects the signatory to the full respect the Payment Terms of this order. Failure to respect the Payment Terms may result in the sponsor product being refused without refund.

Given serious cause the ESC is entitled to postpone, to curtail the duration, to close the industry activities completely or in part for any period, or to cancel the Event.

In the event of complete or part postponement or curtailment, the order form is regarded as valid for a possible new date and new duration for the said Event. If, for any reason, ESC Congress 2020 – The Digital Experience has to be cancelled, the ESC will refund the sponsor the sum paid at the time of the cancellation.

The ESC acts in good faith and is not liable for refund of contracted services in the case of regulatory or legislative bodies refusing the content of same.
