





- **4,025** registered delegates from **136** countries/territories

Age and gender of registered delegates




Live programme

- **1,033 delegates** attended the live programme over the 4 days of Digital Health week (attendees)



Unique Viewers - Live programme




- **45%** of attendees attended on more than 1 of the 4 days (ESC Congress: 53%).


- *'Devices and mobile applications in cardiology'*, the first session broadcast from Digital Health week, had the highest number of live attendees with **494 delegates** logging on to watch during the course of the broadcast.

- **14:00** – the average amount of time delegates spent watching on-demand content.




Event attendees

- **1,033 delegates** (25.7% of total registered delegates) from **97 countries** logged on to the congress platform to watch sessions live as they were broadcast.
- A further 148 delegates logged on to the congress platform during congress dates and only viewed on-demand content.
- **In total, 1,181 delegates** (29.3% of total registered delegates (ESC Congress: 62%)) logged on to the congress platform during the congress dates and watched live and/or on-demand sessions.



Attendee profiles

- **1,181** delegates (29.3% of total registered delegates) from **105** countries/territories logged on to the congress platform during the congress dates and watched live and/or on-demand sessions.
- **76%** of delegates came from NCS countries (ESC Congress 2020: 45%);
- **18%** from ACS countries (ESC Congress 2020: 47%);
- **6%** from rest of world (ESC Congress 2020: 8%)
- **45%** of delegates were under 40 (ESC Congress 2020: 53%)
- **43%** of delegates were female (ESC Congress 2020: 44%)
