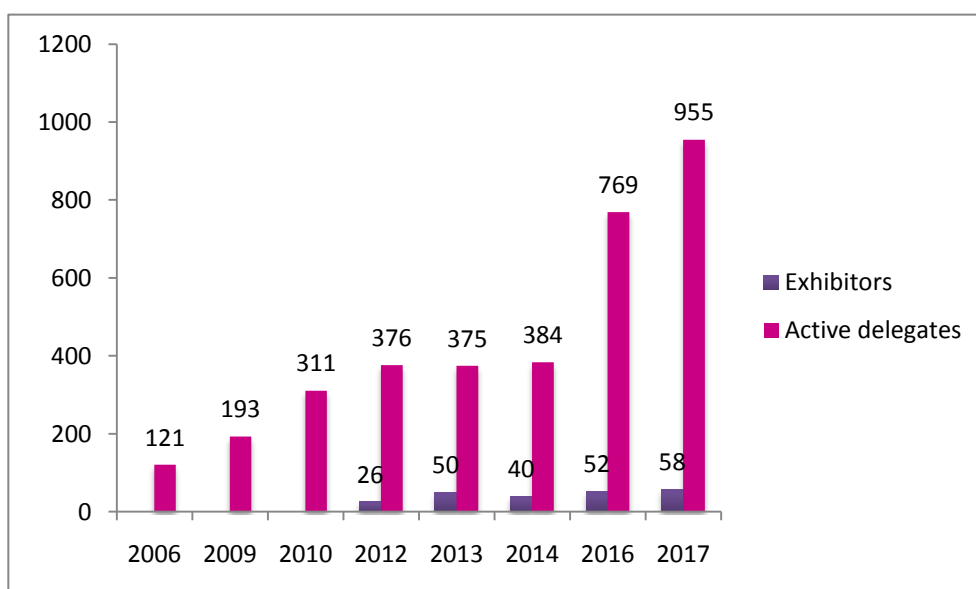

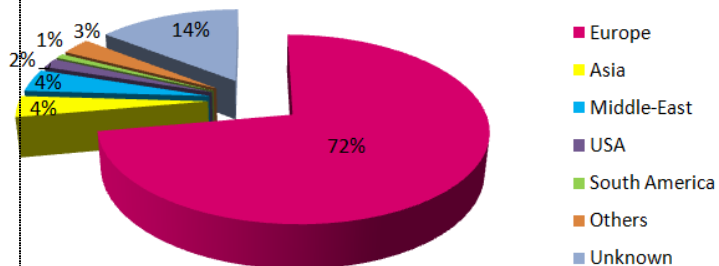

Attendance breakdown 2006-2017

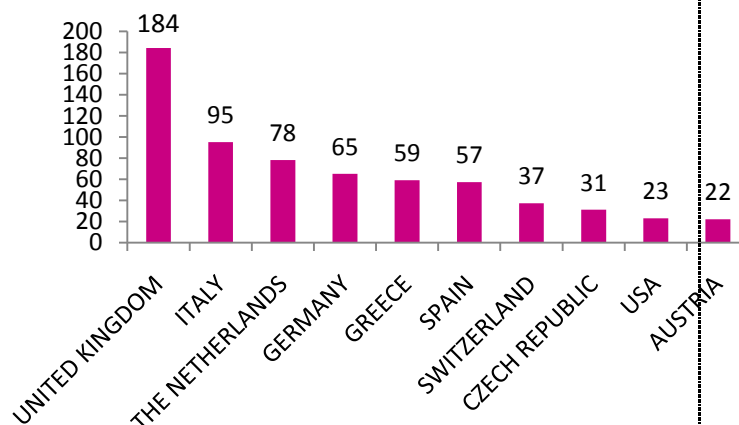

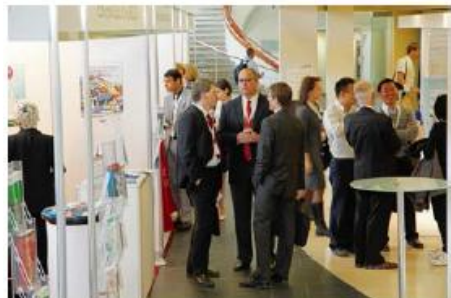

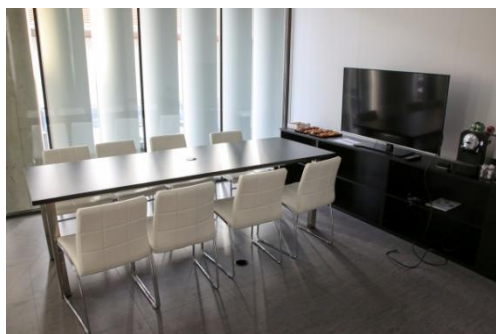
The rooms include a standard set-up. Meeting Rooms organisers are responsible for additional furniture, AV equipment and catering arrangements.
