Available to promote Satellite Symposia, User Group Sessions and exhibiting stands. A Weblink is an invitation (PDF or HTML) created by companies, in the form of a page, linked to the EUROECHO 2007 website.

1 weblink promotes 1 event (Satellite Symposium, User Group Session or Exhibition details).

- 1 weblink promoting 1 session with reference to the booth will be considered as 1 weblink.
- 1 weblink promoting 2 sessions will be considered as 2 weblinks.

3.1 Procedure

The exhibiting company must send an application form dully filled in. The ESC will issue the invoice. The company must send the URL address or PDF of the weblink in order to be approved by ESC before linking to the EUROECHO 2007 website. Deadline for application: 31 May 2007

3.2 Cost € 1 000 per weblink

3.3 Invoicing Weblink(s) are invoiced when the application form is received.

3.4 Cancellation fee

Once the invoice has been issued, cancellation will incur a 100% cancellation fee.

3.5 Website location

The weblink will be placed on the company name and also on this image: WM, whether it leads to a PDF or to an HTML page.

The site visitor clicks on the link, which then opens the PDF or HTML page in a new window on his or her screen.

3.6 Technical aspects The weblink can be a PDF or a HTML invitation.

PDF pageWeight: the lighter the better (100 – 400 Kb)Security: ideally lockedOpen size: ideally 100%Number of pages: 1 – 2Images: may be included

HTML page Provide ESC with the invitation URL, not the company website URL.
