

The ESC Council on Basic Cardiovascular Science (CBCS) enhances basic and translational science within the ESC. It is composed of representatives from several ESC Working Groups and from the major basic science organisations in Europe.

This collaborative forum:

- Promotes pure science disciplines
- 2. Bridges the gap between basic science and clinical practice.

Created in 2004, one of the Council's first tasks was to enhance the basic science component of the ESC Congress. With the introduction of its "pre-scope process" the Council has contributed to the increase in quality and coverage of basic science sessions at the event. It has introduced a series of highly competitive awards to recognise personal excellence and to encourage the career development of young basic scientists. A community of young scientists - the "Scientists of Tomorrow"- exists under the banner of the Council with the aim of promoting basic science and contributing to the scientific, educational and advocacy activities of the ESC.

The Council is strongly linked to the ESC journal *Cardiovascular Research* (CVR). The Editor-in-Chief is an ex officio member of the ESC CBCS.

About the Congress

The Frontiers in CardioVascular Biomedicine meetings are increasingly considered as one of the most relevant exchange platforms for basic and translational cardiovascular biology. 




