

ELECTRICAL TO DO LIST FOR YOUR BOOTH AT IFEMA

Things to keep in mind before ordering electricity from IFEMA...



Is your stand a shell scheme package ordered through the official supplier?

Is your stand a free-design stand?



<u>Included in your booth floorspace are the following electrical services:</u>

- o 130 w of consumption per square meter
- o 1 Main electrical connection ending in a Marechal plug or open points, depending on the wattage. (NOTE: Not a CETAC).

So, for example a 50m2 stand would automatically be provided with:

- o 130 w x 50m2 = 6500w / 6.5kw
- o 1 Main electrical connection



You and/or your stand-builder need to work out if you need to order any additional consumption and main electrical connections.

Above and beyond the minimum, exhibitors can order as much additional electricity as they require.

So, for example, if the same 50m2 requires a total of 30kw, divided among 2 main electrical connections, they would need to order and indicate the following:

- o Consumption: 30 kw the 6.5kw min. already included = 23.5 additional kw to be ordered
- Main electrical connections: 2 main connections the 1 min. connection already included = 1 additional connection to be ordered



<u>IFEMA can also offer you any other electrical services that you may require</u>, such as fuseboards, extension cables, certificates, etc. You can find all these services in the EAGE Exhibitors website.

<u>IFEMA Certification regulations are very strict</u> and, if don't hire fuseboard+certificate packs from the venue, it is still the exhibitor's / stand-builder's responsibility to ensure that a Spanish-licensed electrician coordinates the Electrical Installation Certificate with the Regional Government of Madrid.

To make life easier, you can purchase just the certificates from IFEMA. Note that almost 100% of foreign stand-builders need to end up hiring the certificate from IFEMA and those that order onsite go to the back of the line so to ensure as few headaches as possible during you build, we suggest you order these ahead of time.



<u>IFEMA needs to know where you want your services installed</u>, so always send us a floorplan of your stand indicating the location of your main connections and required consumption for each connection.

PLEASE NOTE that fuseboards and sockets must always be ordered separately as the provision of the main connections and electrical consumption does not include the installation of fuseboards or any other services.
