



Schedule overview

The Scientific Programme was organised over 5 rooms during the entire congress. In addition, a total of 8 sessions were organised in 2 extra rooms on the first and last days.

All the rooms were live broadcasted online on the congress platform, on channels 1 to 7. The online audience was able to follow the live sessions and interact via an online chat (commenting and asking questions). Questions from the online audience were relayed by the chairpersons of the session.

There were also 6 ePosters stations and 2 moderated ePosters stations, as well as a virtual case area.

Per the statement released by the ESC on 4 March 2022 regarding the war in Ukraine, the ESC did not accept active contributors to the scientific programme from Russian and/or Belarusian institutions. Faculty, abstract and case presenters were removed from the Scientific programme.












