### 1 - POSTER BOARDS

For each Satellite Symposium or User Group Session organised, the ICNC Secretariat is providing **1 poster board** in the Congress venue, near Registration.

Companies organising Satellite Symposium and or User Group Session are thus able to promote their event by presenting posters in advance of their session.

#### Posters

The **poster** must be left **on site** at the **ICNC8 office**— for the attention of Celia Conil between Saturday 28 April and Monday 30 April.

THE ESC WILL PUT UP THE POSTERS.

The posters must be A0 **paper** posters portrait format (83 cm X 118 cm) maximum. The lighter the better!

**No rigid posters will be displayed.**

#### Display times

Posters will only be displayed together during the following times:

- For Satellite Symposia / User Group Sessions scheduled on Sunday, 29 April 2007 during the afternoon: from **08:30 – 18:00**
- For Satellite Symposia / User Group Sessions scheduled on Monday, 30 April 2007 during the lunch timeslot: from **08:30 – 14:00**
- For Satellite Symposia / User Group Sessions scheduled on Monday, 30 April 2007 during the evening timeslot: from **14:00 – 20:00**
- For Satellite Symposia / User Group Sessions scheduled on Tuesday, 1 May 2007 during the lunch timeslot: from **08:30 – 14:00**

### 2 – LECTURE ROOMS POSTERS & INVITATIONS

- Display of **two** posters in front of the lecture rooms 30 minutes before the beginning of the sessions on the 2 easels provided by the event organisers, the advised size is A1 (40 X 60 cm) portrait format and rigid posters
- Instead of usual posters, two portable display units of maximum height of 2,5m and maximum width of 1m (no electrical connection, no light and no sound) are also allowed.
- Handing out of invitations at the entrance of the assigned room 30 minutes before the beginning of the session. **Please restrict the distribution of invitations to where permitted.**

#### N.B

- **As already stated all posters must have the specific written approval of ESC. All unauthorised material will be removed by the ESC.**
- DO NOT MAIL THE POSTERS TO ESC.
- Hostesses handing out invitations at the main entrance are not permitted.
- Posters and Invitations are not permitted in the building other than on the booth or in front the Satellite Symposia / Meet the Experts Session assigned lecture room.
